

## IRODaT: 2005 donation and transplantation preliminary figures

As years before, during this year the International Registry of Organ Donation and Transplantation will publish in three terms the information collected through the worldwide net of professionals involved in transplant coordination.

The current issue includes the preliminary values of deceased and living donors and total deceased organ transplants: kidney, liver, heart, lung, pancreas and intestine. All data reported is presented in absolute values and in rates of parts per million population. The values displayed in this first issue have been reported along January 2006, so they must be read as a preview of the definitive data, which will be published in the next edition of *Organs, Tissues and Cells* journal.

IRODaT is available in the Internet at [www.tpm.org](http://www.tpm.org). It is a useful exploiting data tool for epidemiological and demographic studies covering a consistent up-to-date global situation on organ donation, transplant donors sources, types, and technical performances.

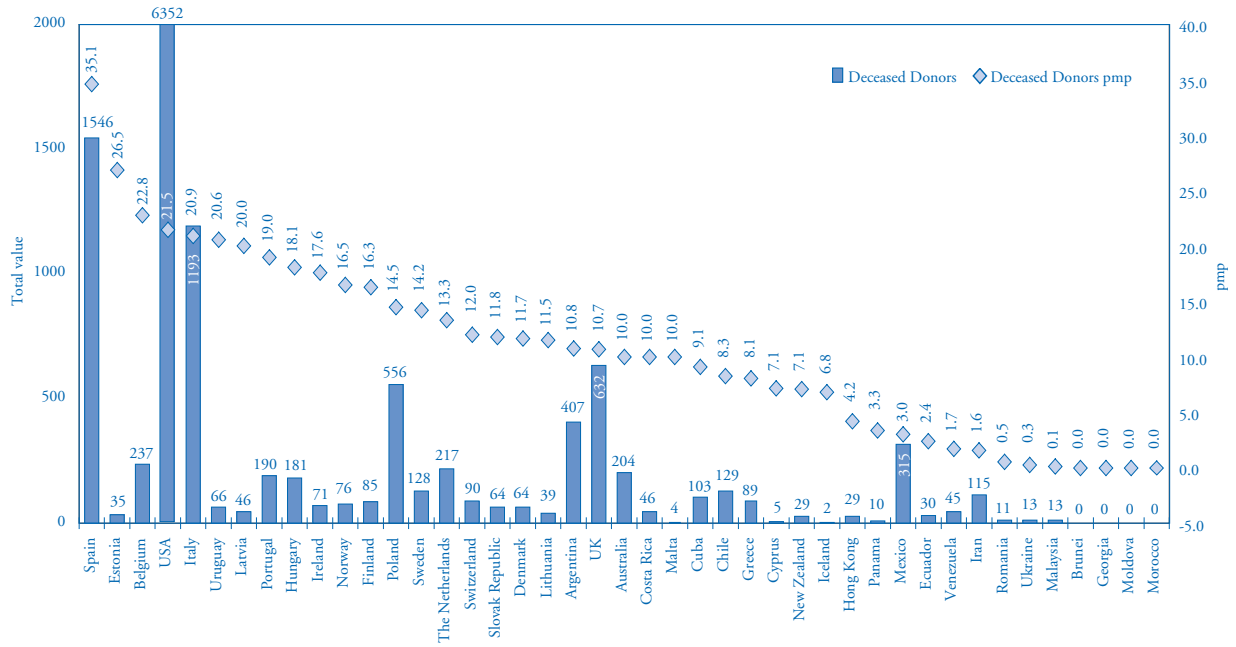

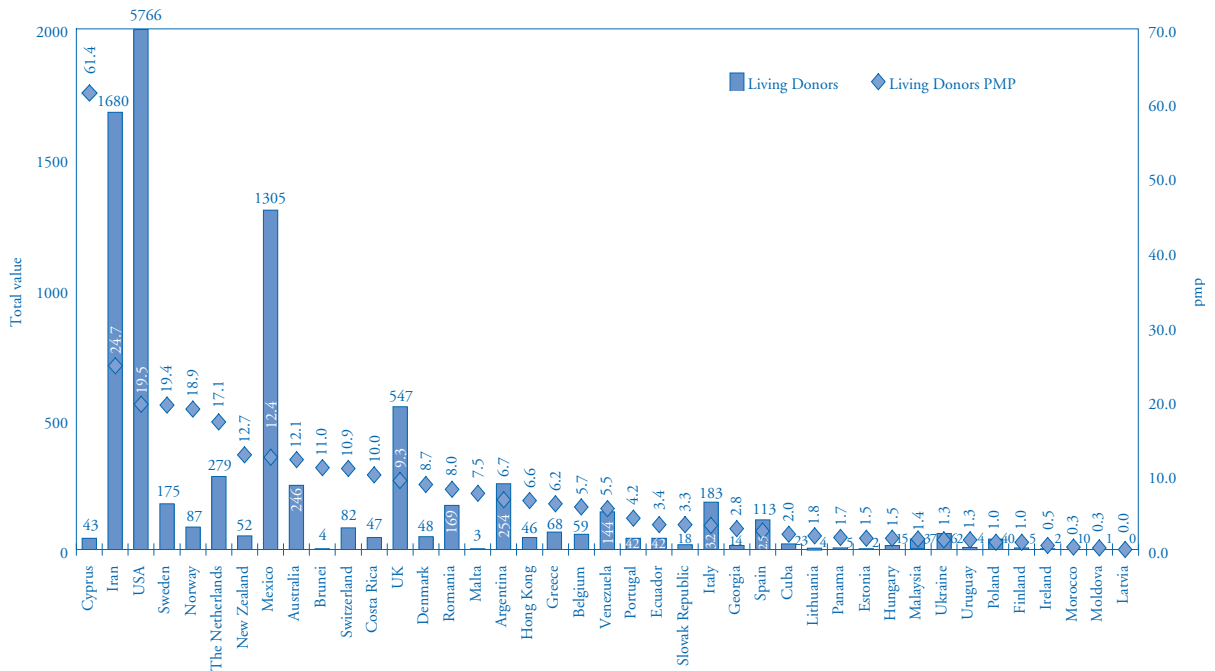

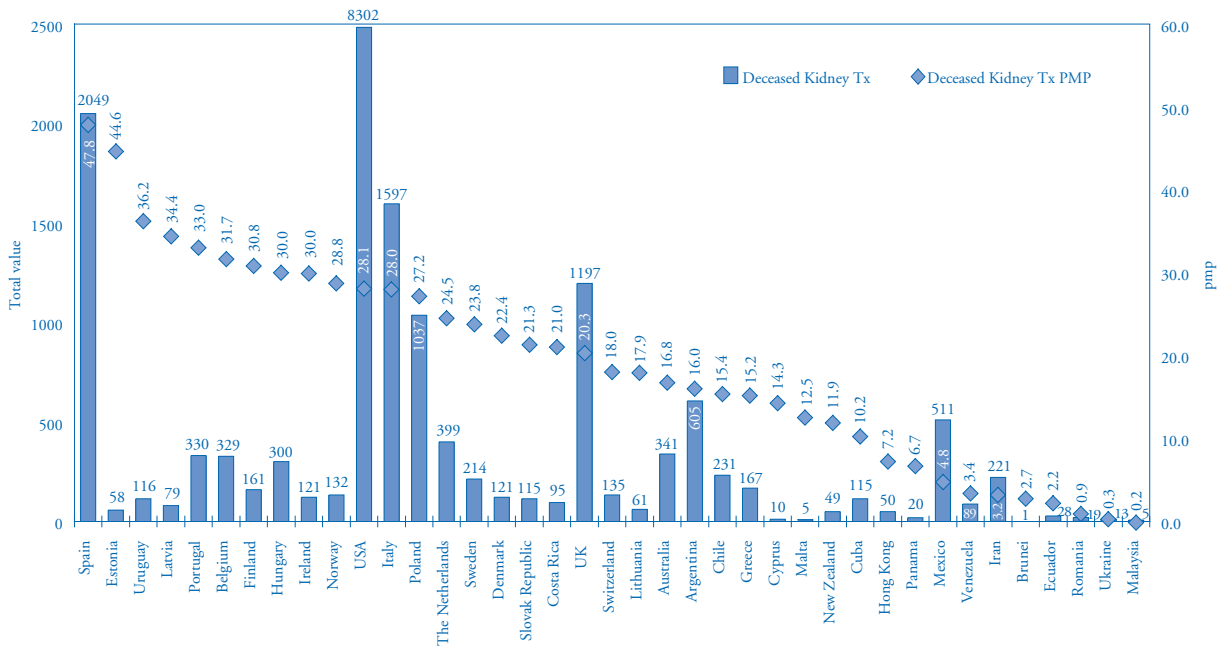
### Preliminary deceased donors 2005



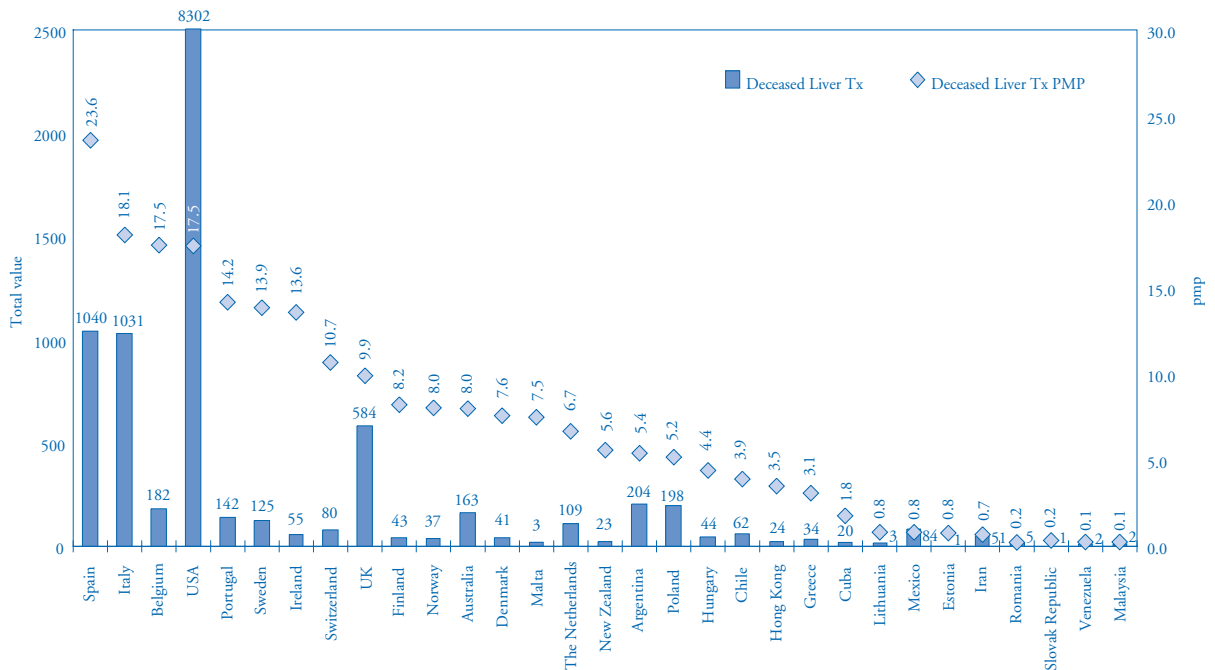
### Preliminary living donors 2005



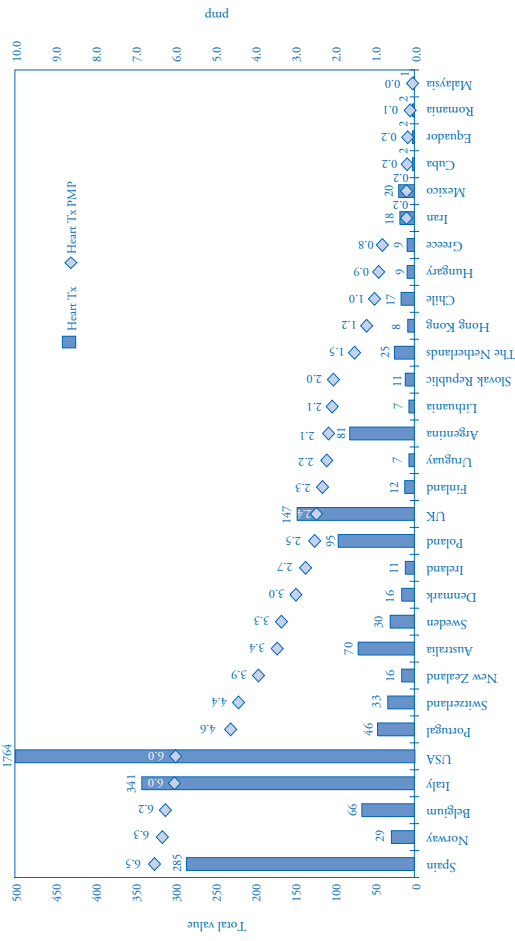
### Preliminary deceased kidney transplants 2005



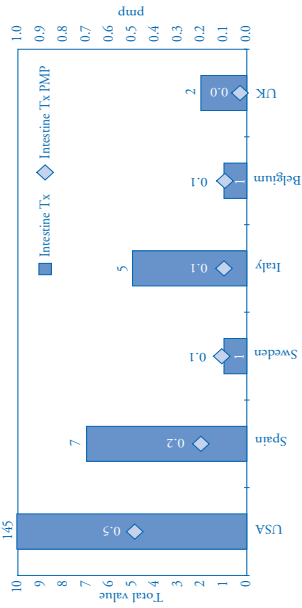
### Preliminary deceased liver transplants 2005



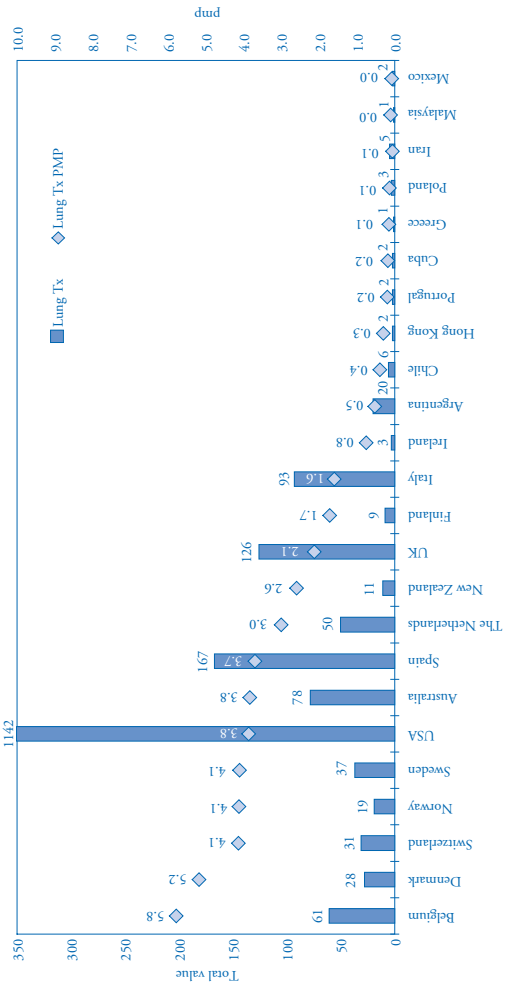
